PARISH AMALGAMATIONS/ Groupings: As part of the Diocesan Pastoral plan 'Seeds of Hope', new Pastoral Areas have been established, where groups of parishes are asked to work together and support each other. This will involve change and the possibility of some change to mass times in each parish so that priests can cover for each other. Our Grouping is – Caherconlish, Caherline, Ballybricken, Bohermore, Herbertstown, Hospital, Knockainey & Patrickswell. Parishes will retain their identity and financial independence. This is foremost a pastoral arrangement. In 5 years time, in the Archdiocese, there will be 35 priests under 75 with 48 parishes to serve.
