#### **CHURCH FUND – CONTRIBUTION ENVELOPES**



The Caherconlish/Caherline Committee advises the Parish Priest in all areas pertaining to the financial management and administration of parochial assets and keeps parishioner informed through an annual report at a public meeting each year. The Committee meets at least three times a year, or as necessary.
