#### Praying the Scriptures during LENT.

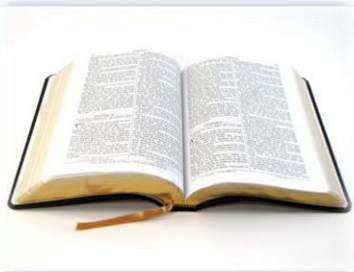
