ON VOCATIONS:

The current shortage of vocations to the priesthood and religious life could be discerned as God calling for change in the Church, Archbishop Dermot Farrell of Dublin has said. In his homily on the Feast of St Kevin the archbishop said: “Perhaps the Lord is indicating that it is time to make the necessary choices to build new models of ministry.” He underlined that a decreasing number of priests cannot limit themselves to an ever-increasing number of sacramental celebrations. “This situation requires decision and discernment to know what we bring with us from the past into the future.” It also implied “a different role and a new self-understanding by those of us in ministerial priesthood” and that there must be an appreciation that all the baptised share this mission. Archbishop Farrell stressed that the new face of the Church must be one where women and young people have a different visibility.

EAVES-DROPPINGS:

The Presidential party - US President Joe Biden and his wife Dr Jill Biden – were 15 minutes late for the service (Probably a legacy of his Irish DNA!) in St Ives. At the end of the Mass the President had a few words with some of the congregation who say they saw him make a “substantial” donation to the collection. Unusually for the church the bulk of the money given by the congregation this week were dollar bills.
