1. Km WALK OF MERCY
SUNDAY 11th SEPTEMBER
EMLY, CO. TIPPERARY- 3.00pm

Join us on Sunday 11th September at 3.00pm in Emly, as we walk in the footsteps of St. Ailbe on a 1.Km walk on the holy ground of Ailbe to the parish church in Emly. This invitation is extended to all who live in Caherconlish/Caherline parish, whether young or old, people of Faith or not, to join with the people of the old Emly diocese who will gather on pilgrimage to honour St. Ailbe- whose feast day is marked each year on the 12th September- and to celebrate the Holy Year of Mercy 2016 called by Pope Francis.

Archbishop Kieran O'Reilly, will lead the pilgrimage. Pilgrims from Caherconlish/Caherline Parish are asked to assemble in Emly at **Carroll's Cross (parking in field, Assembly Point 2 west side of the village.)**

Parishes, clubs and organisations are asked to walk behind their banners, / or Callanan's Cross, Assembly Point 1 east side of the village.

There will be a Minibus service available at these points for assisted pilgrims. Choirs will lead the congregational singing, if you would like to join the singing for St. Ailbe's Walk of Mercy, Choir practices will be held in Emly Parish Church on Wednesday Evenings August 31st and September 7th at 8pm.

On the grounds of the monastery, St. Ailbe will be honoured in word, song and prayer. Archbishop O'Reilly will open the Holy Year Door, as pilgrims pass through it they will bless themselves with water from St. Ailbe's Well. Each parish will carry in procession water from its own local holy well. The ceremony will conclude at 5pm and all pilgrims will be given a bottle of water from St. Ailbe's Well to take home as a memento of this special event.
