Sr. Agnes, 89, has devoted much of her life to the rehabilitation of people who have lost their way in life due to a dependency on alcohol or drugs or indeed having become addicted to gambling. At the Bruree centre, Sr Agnes and her staff of around 40, support those suffering from addiction, and their families, as they progress through a systematic 12-week programme for alcohol and gambling, and a 20-week programme for substance misuse.
