Might you STEP forward? Would you consider it? If so, know that there is a part-time preparation programme due to begin this autumn at Mary Immaculate College, St. Patrick's Campus, Thurles. A 'taster' of it will run for one Saturday per month, over six months. If, at that stage you're happy with direction of the programme, then you can enter a 2-year part-time programme that reaches Level 6 Certificate.
